# Indoor Skydiving

*for Friday, January 10, 2020*

The iFLY experience begins with your group going into a training room with one of our trainers to learn about indoor skydiving, how to fly in the tunnel and safety, while the rest of the group watches people fly. Each person in the group gets to work with a professional coach, practicing flight positions and hand signals before they actually fly.

After training, the group will go to the gear room to change into a flight suit, goggles and helmet. We recommend that everyone come in pants and tennis shoes that can be worn under the flight suits.

When everyone is suited up, the group goes into the tunnel area. All participants in the group sit in the tunnel area and one by one, each person takes turns going into the tunnel to fly one-on-one with a professional coach. Each rotation is one minute long, which is longer than a real skydive. Each person gets two rotations. Although flying is the best part, watching your friends fly is also great fun and also a great learning experience. The last two minutes in each group is a flying stunt demo performed by one of our coaches -- always exciting and fun.

After the flight is over, each flyer gets a personalized Commemorative Flight Certificate. After indoor skydiving, participants will be transferred to Tin Roof, where they will enjoy lunch, before returning to the hotel.

**NOTES:**

- Attendees must fill out a waiver prior to arrival.
- All participants must wear closed toed shoes.
- Flight restrictions: maximum weight of 300 lbs., no medical history of heart, neck or back problems, no history of shoulder dislocations, women that are pregnant or think they may be should not fly, no hard casts.
- All group members should wear comfortable clothes. The best footwear to wear: well-fitting lace-up sneakers, or running shoes. Other shoes are not suitable. Wear casual clothes, preferably pants or shorts and a shirt with no collar.



# Bass Fishing

Large mouth bass are caught with conventional or fly tackle depending on your guest's preference. Each of the boats can accommodate two passengers and a professional guide.

All tackle and live "wild" shiners are included. Each boat is equipped with a cooler stocked with assorted soft drinks and water. Experienced, professional guides will ensure an exciting day of fishing for the novice or experienced fisherman. While fishing, guests may see and experience first-hand a wild variety of birds and wild life including the Florida alligator, Bald Eagles and many more!

After a fun morning of fishing guests will be transferred to a local restaurant to enjoy lunch.

Winter Park is located just minutes from downtown Orlando and offers a variety of activities, shopping and dining options. Known for its upscale neighborhoods, fascinating art museums and renowned eateries, Winter Park is a great spot for your group to spend the day!

### SCENIC BOAT TOUR

Our day begins with the Scenic Boat Tour, a Winter Park tradition. Guests will enjoy the narrated one hour cruise through the beautiful lakes and canals of historic Winter Park aboard open-air pontoon boats. Guests will experience breathtaking views of opulent private homes and exquisite estates along the shores. Tour guides are sure to point out sites such as Rollins College, the Albin Polasek Museum & Sculpture Gardens, Kraft Azalea Gardens and more.

Following the boat tour, guests will be transferred to The Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art on Park Avenue. The centerpiece of the Morse Museum collection is undoubtedly the work of Louis Comfort Tiffany.

### MORSE MUSEUM - TIFFANY COLLECTION

Among the most fascinating objects in the Museum's Tiffany collection are the brilliantly colored windows, mosaics, marble, jewels, glass, stone, and furnishings that make up the chapel interior that Tiffany created for the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago.

The Museum's Tiffany collection also includes a large number of pieces originally housed at Tiffany's Long Island country estate, Laurelton Hall. The Laurelton Hall materials include the artist's most prized paintings, art glass, pottery, and furniture as well as windows, lamps, and other objects that made their debut at international expositions and later adorned his home.

Audio tours are complimentary and available via cell phone.

### PARK AVENUE

After touring the museum, guests will have plenty of free time to explore Park Avenue. A group lunch can be organized at one of the many fine dining establishments along the Avenue or guests can enjoy lunch on their own. Park Avenue has long been the place for a relaxing stroll in elegant surroundings. Bordered by a shady park that plays host to concerts and art festivals, Park Avenue is home to one-of-a-kind boutiques and well-known shops, sidewalk cafes and fine dining restaurants.

### EXPERIENCES OFFERED

#### ATV'S

Experience what an amazing ATV ride entails! Feel the adrenalin rush as you have fun maneuvering over the acres of sand humps, grass banks, dirt trails and off-road terrain. This is not suited for the hard-core mud and forest "off roaders", but certainly everyone should be prepared to get dirty!

#### "MUCKY DUCKS"

Mucky Ducks is an 8-wheeled amphibious adventure vehicle designed for fun on the land and in the water! Get up close and personal with the beautiful Floridian wilderness on trails tailor-made for adventure – allowing you the unique opportunity to drive through the wooded areas and then plunge into the lake and wetlands.

#### CLAY SHOOTING

The clay targets flying across the sky may look impossible to hit, but after some practice and some good coaching, you may just surprise yourself. Using a double-barreled over and under shotgun, you will work with a range master to learn the safe and correct way to shoot down clay's. *25 rounds per person, including ear defenders and eye glasses.*

#### TARGET ARCHERY

This amazingly addictive sport is growing rapidly every year. See if you have what it takes to hit a target up to 100 yards away on the specially prepared outdoor range. Genesis compound bows are available for left and right-handed archers and coaches will on-site to assist.

- Casual attire with long pants is recommended. Closed toe shoes are required. Participants should be prepared to get very dirty.
  - Vendor requires the following information to be provided: photo identity and proof of age. All participants must be over the age of 16 years to ride and should be in good physical health.
  - Participants will be asked to sign and complete waiver acceptance and liability forms prior to participation in any activity.
  - Safety equipment provided must be worn at all times.
  - For Clay Shooting, you must be over 16 to shoot our under and over shot guns.
  - Animals on the property are part of the Revolution conservation wildlife alliance and may not be interfered with, provoked or harmed in any way.



Built in 1967 as a means for NASA Astronauts' and employees' families to view space center operations, today the Visitor Complex is one of Central Florida's popular destinations.

Our ongoing space journey can be defined by significant eras. That's why we've organized Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex into Mission Zones — grouped attractions and experiences reflecting specific periods of time and achievements. Your journey awaits!

**NOTES:** • Attire is casual.

- At this time, the following items are not permitted at the Visitor Complex: Firearms of any type (with or without a permit including law enforcement officers), Live Ammunition, Pepper/mace sprays, Knives over 3 ½ inches long, or with a fixed blade such as a hunting knife, or any switchblade (automatic opening knife or ballistic knife), Box cutters or like items.
- All bags, purses and other items will be opened and inspected at the Visitor Complex. (Procedures to search all bags carried into the complex by visitors & employees are actions taken as part of the increase in security and not part of a specific threat to our facilities).
- If any of the above items are discovered, you will be asked to return them to your vehicle. If you choose not to return the items to your vehicle, you must surrender them to a Security Officer. Surrendered items will not be returned to you. All guests have to go through the metal detectors, so please reduce the number of items you normally carry.
